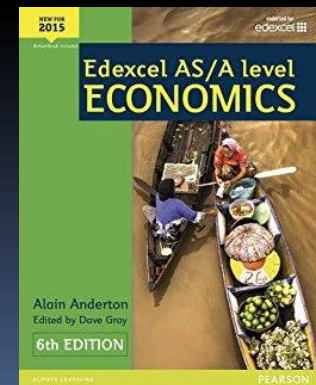
# WHAT CAN YOU DO TO SUPPORT YOUR CHILD?
