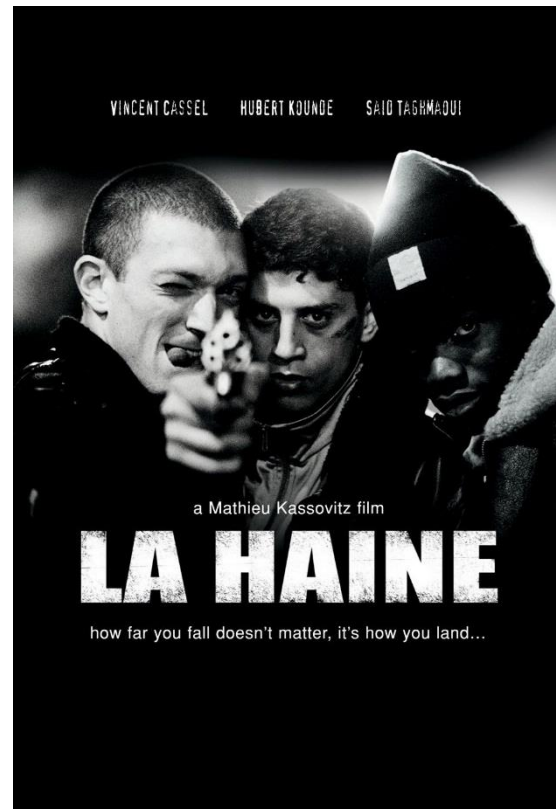
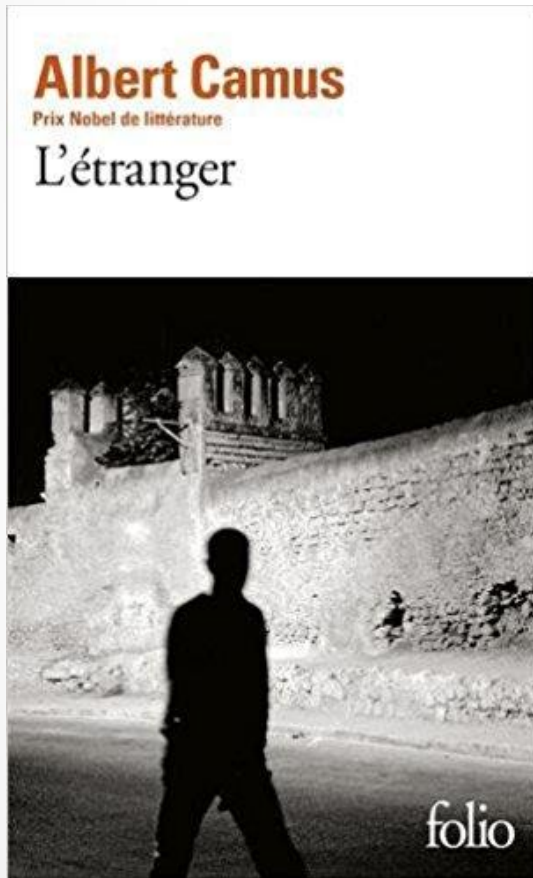

A Level French

- Paper 1 – Listening, Reading and Translation, this paper lasts 2 hours
- Paper 2 – Response to works, grammar and translation (You will have to answer questions on a film and a literary text) 2 hours and 40 minutes
- Paper 3 – Speaking – discussion on a theme based on a stimulus card, and presentation and discussion on an independent research project.
- 21 – 23 minutes.
